## **INTRODUCTION**

The grade 9 religion course, *The Ministry of Christ*, is the first course in Religious Studies for students in high school. This course is designed as a historical overview of the life and ministry of Jesus Christ as found in the New Testament books of *Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John*.

The purposes of this course are these: First, to learn the significance of these Bible books and Bible passages within them; second, to understand the difficult parts in them; third, to draw out practical applications for your life.

This course is one of the four religion courses required to obtain a Rehoboth Christian School Diploma (RCSD). It also serves as one of the elective credits towards the Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD). It is the hope of your parents, teacher, and school board that this course will be a blessing to your soul.

## **CLASS ROUTINE**

You need to bring the ***Reformation Heritage KJV Study Bible*** to class every day. A portion of scripture will be read in class every day, and reference will be made to the Bible throughout the lesson. We will take turns reading verses, and you will need to follow along in your own Bible so that you know what and when to read. Since we are all using the same Reference Bible, we can all turn to the same reference pages to look up maps, charts, concordance, and refer to the same page numbers. It is important to emphasize the need for respect for the Word of God during Bible reading.

You also need to bring your textbook, ***The Ministry of Christ***, because readings and questions will be assigned from this text from time to time.

At the beginning of each unit, you will receive a package of ***course notes***, which will be filled in during the daily lesson. The course notes have bullets, charts, or points that need to be completed for study purposes. The notes also contain review sheets to prepare unit tests, and review questions for the final exam. You will only get **one copy** of these notes. If you lose them, you will have to photocopy or purchase a new one.

You may have a drink bottle with water in the classroom, provided that it has a closable lid.
